The Farmville Chamber of Commerce strives to promote and support our local businesses in a variety of ways. We would be delighted to help your business make its presence known in our community and our county with a *Ribbon Cutting Ceremony*. To participate in a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony, your business must meet one of the following criteria:

- Your business is an active member of The Chamber.
- Opened its doors anytime in the last three years.
- Changed ownership or welcomed new management in the last three years.
- Moved to a new location in the last three years.
- Expanded or significantly remodeled at the current location in the last three years.

Even if you have been here for more than two years or made a significant change to your business in the last few years, you are still eligible to hold a Ribbon Cutting ceremony. THERE IS NO COST TO HAVE A RIBBON CUTTING EVENT AND THE CHAMBER WILL PLAN, CONDUCT AND PROMOTE IT.

A Ribbon Cutting Ceremony offers you an opportunity to officially announce your presence in the community and receive publicity and promotion for your business. The ceremony is also a celebration of your connection to the Chamber and to Farmville, and it highlights your participation in the business activities of the town.

The Farmville Chamber of Commerce will conduct the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony, which includes a few words spoken by the Mayor and/or a town official, as well as the Executive Director of the Chamber of Commerce and/or a member of the Chamber Board of Directors. *The business owner is then asked to make a few comments*. The Chamber will request that the newspaper is present to cover the event. Pictures also will be taken to post on social media.

Scheduling the event with the Chamber should occur a few weeks prior to the event to provide ample time to contact the newspaper and arrange for two to three officials to attend the event. The Chamber will provide the ribbon and scissors.
